What do a florist, a photographer, owners of a wedding chapel & bed & breakfast owners have in common? If you're in-tuned with what's happening in our culture today, you probably guessed it. All are being sued by same-sex couples because they refused to provide services to those couples on their wedding days! We can expect to see an avalanche of these types of law suits since the US Supreme Court's decision to legalize same-sex marriage in all states.
