Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, one of America's most gifted writers was a believer in Jesus Christ.

The year 1861 was a most difficult year for him. His wife tragically died when her dress caught fire in their home in Massachusetts. That same year civil war broke out tearing our nation apart. Two years into the war, Henry's son was shot during a fierce battle. Henry went immediately to bring his son home to care for him, as he said his wife would have wanted. On December 25, 1863 (Christmas Day), while in despair he was trying to write a song. In the midst of his grief, with head bowed he heard them, Christmas bells ringing in the distance. While listening he wrote verse 3

- *"And in despair I bowed my head. There is no peace on earth I said. For hate is strong and mocks the song of peace on earth good will to men".* Then verse 4:
- *"Then pealed the bells more loud and deep, God is not dead nor doth He sleep. The wrong shall foil, the right prevail, with peace on earth good will to men".*

So please remember this Christmas, that all does not have to be exactly as you want it to be to have a Merry Christmas. God is all you need to truly celebrate this season. In the midst of shopping, traffic, busy schedules, hurt, pain, loneliness, long lines, and short tempers, listen for the Christmas bells and remember – God is always available and eager for you to hide yourself in Him, or as Mr. Longfellow put it, "God is not dead nor doth He sleep".
