During our morning worship service on Sunday, February 15th we will receive the first of four offerings to fund the construction of a new church building in India. Working with Abraham Thomas & Agape Royal Ministries our congregation has generously given to finance the building of three churches in India in recent years. India is the second most populous country in the world with over one billion people. There are more than 4,000 unreached people groups in the world—2,027 of them are in India. More than 400 million people who live in India have never heard the name of Jesus. Agape Royal Ministries began church planting in India in 1997 with two churches. Today there are about 300 churches planted in Nepal & in 11 states in India. We can play a big part in helping Brother Abraham & the pastors that God is raising up in India reach their nation with the Good News of Jesus Christ by giving graciously to this ministry of church planting. Please pray that we will reach our goal this year of \$6,000 for new church construction in India so that our brothers & sisters in Christ will have a place to gather for worship & be a light in the darkness of their villages. ~ Pastor Randy (Matthew 28:19-20)
