



# Macedonian Call

## July 2017

Recently much media attention has focused on US Senate hearings featuring the testimonies of former FBI Director Jim Comey and current Attorney General Sessions. While those hearings garnered the public's attention, there was another senate hearing which took place early June that received much less press. What came out of that hearing was alarming and revealed, in my opinion, a more serious threat to our democracy than Russian interference in our electoral processes. In the hearing to which I am referring, Russell Vought, the president's choice for second-in-command at the Office of Management and Budget was berated for his Christian faith by senator and former presidential nominee, Bernie Sanders of Vermont. At issue was a column Vought wrote last year suggesting that Jesus Christ is the only way to salvation. Below is a transcript of the appalling attack.

**Sanders:** "Muslims do not simply have a deficient theology. They do not know God because they have rejected Jesus Christ, His Son, and they stand condemned.' Do you believe that that statement is Islamophobic?"

**Vought:** "Absolutely not, Senator. I'm a Christian, and I believe in a Christian set of principles based on my faith..."

**Sanders:** "...Forgive me, we just don't have a lot of time. Do you believe people in the Muslim religion stand condemned? Is that your view?"

**Vought:** "Again, Senator, I'm a Christian, and I wrote that piece in accordance with the statement of faith at Wheaton College..."

**Sanders:** "I understand that. I don't know how many Muslims there are in America. Maybe a couple million, that these people stand condemned? What about Jews?"

Do they stand condemned too?"

**Vought:** "Senator, I'm a Christian..."

**Sanders** (shouting): "I understand you are a Christian, but this country [is] made of people who are not just -- I understand that Christianity is the majority religion, but there are other people of different religions in this country and around the world. In your judgment, do you think that people who are not Christians are going to be condemned?"

**Vought:** "Thank you for probing on that question. As a Christian, I believe that all individuals are made in the image of God and are worthy of dignity and respect regardless of their religious beliefs. I believe that as a Christian that's how I should treat all individuals..."


**Sanders:** "...Do you think that's respectful of other religions?... I would simply say, Mr. Chairman that this nominee is really not someone who this country is supposed to be about."

Sanders' comments should cause every Christian to cringe. Mr. Vought's Christian beliefs have nothing to do with his role in the OMB! When has being a Christian or expressing biblical teaching become the basis for disqualifying someone for public office? This outrageous attack wasn't only against Mr. Vought's religious liberty and freedom of expression, it was an attack against all who hold those same beliefs. What is obvious from this exchange is that the senator charging religious discrimination against Mr. Vought was actually guilty of his own charge. As we celebrate the independence of our nation this year we should pray not only for God's continued blessings, we should also pray that He will continue to raise up Christian men and women for public service, giving them both the grace and strength to stand against such outrageous displays of religious discrimination. And, we should unashamedly support and pray for them! *"Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? Who will stand up for me against the workers of iniquity?"* (Psalm 19:16). ~ Pastor Randy
